

Scarborough Energy Project

2025 Community Development Report Summary

The Scarborough Energy Project (the Project) is on track for first liquefied natural gas (LNG) cargo in Q4 2026.

The Project comprises the Scarborough gas field, construction of Pluto Train 2, modifications to the existing Pluto Train 1 and the integrated remote operations centre in Perth. The Scarborough gas field is located in the Carnarvon Basin, approximately 375 km off the Pilbara coast of Western Australia (WA).

The development of the Scarborough gas field includes the construction and installation of a semi-submersible floating production unit, moored in approximately 950 m of water, connected by an approximately 430 km pipeline to a second LNG train (Pluto Train 2) at the existing Pluto LNG onshore facility.

The Project was approved in November 2021 and since then, it has contributed significantly to local communities in Karratha, Roebourne and Exmouth through new jobs, business opportunities and contributions to community.

Importantly for Western Australia, the Project can help to support local energy security by providing up to 225 terajoules (TJ) per day of domestic gas supply into the Western Australian market, including approximately 130 TJ per day for the Perdaman fertiliser plant.

Construction of the new onshore LNG train and related inlet facilities is being executed by the

Engineering, Procurement, and Construction (EPC) contractor, Bechtel.

Since the Pluto Train 2 Project's inception up until 31 December 2025 Bechtel's EPC contract has included subcontracts awarded within Karratha valued at A\$149 million and a further A\$1,078 million in contracts awarded to businesses in the rest of Western Australia. This has resulted in a total of 110 businesses in Karratha and a further 332 businesses in the rest of Western Australia being engaged by Bechtel on the Pluto Train 2 Project.

Almost 1500 Pluto Train 2 project employees from across Western Australia were working on site in Q4 2025. Throughout the year, employees and community alike have benefitted from ongoing investment in programs, events and organisations that aim to build a thriving local community.

Economic Contribution

The Scarborough Energy Project is estimated to spend over **A\$5.4 billion** in WA throughout the development phase of the project.



Regional Development

A total of **110** businesses in Karratha and a further **332** businesses in the rest of Western Australia have been engaged by Bechtel on the Pluto Train 2 Project.



Employment

In Q4 2025, a total of **1,498** Pluto Train 2 project employees were from Western Australia.



91 Australian Indigenous employees were employed on the Pluto Train 2 Project under Bechtel's EPC contract.

Skills Development and Training



26 people were trained on the Pluto Train 2 Project construction by Woodside and its contractor, Bechtel.

Our contractor, Bechtel and their subcontractors, have awarded **43** contracts to Indigenous businesses since the Train 2 Project's inception.

Woodside and Bechtel worked with the **Ngarliyarndu Bindirri Aboriginal Corporation** to deliver a 'work-ready' program for the Pluto Train 2 Project. At the end of 2025, **5** participants were employed and engaged in the program.

Community Investment



The Scarborough Joint Venture co-funded the installation of the **Dampier Artificial Reef** designed to support local fishers and enhance marine biodiversity off the Western Australian coast.

Throughout 2025, the Student Support Hub at Exmouth District High School was accessed by **536** students.

The Scarborough JV and Pluto Train 2 Projects contributed to the five-year **community development partnership** with the City of Karratha, which contributes to a range of liveability programs and events.

Woodside's Community Grants Program supported **35** community organisations in 2025.



The Scarborough Joint Venture comprises Woodside (Operator) 74.9%, JERA Scarborough Pty Ltd 15.1% and LJ Scarborough Pty Ltd (LNG Japan) 10%. The Pluto Train 2 Joint Venture comprises Woodside (Operator) 51% and Global Infrastructure Partners (via its investment vehicle Sharon Acquirer Pty Ltd in its capacity as trustee of the Sharon Acquirer Trust) 49%. The Pluto Joint Venture comprises Woodside (Operator) 90%, Kansai Electric Power Australia Pty Ltd 5% and MidOcean Pluto Pty Ltd 5%.
