

Mexico Addendum to the Woodside Privacy Statement

If you are in Mexico, this addendum applies to Woodside's handling of your personal information.

Woodside Petróleo Operaciones de México, S. de R.L. de C.V.; Woodside Energía Holdings de México, S. de R.L. de C.V.; Woodside Energía Servicios de México, S. de R.L. de C.V.; Woodside Energía Servicios Administrativos, S. de R.L. de C.V.; Operaciones Conjuntas, S. de R.L. de C.V., and its subsidiaries and affiliates in Mexico (jointly, “**Woodside Energy Mexico**”), with domicile at Av. Ejército Nacional 769, Torre B Piso 3, Colonia Granada, Alcaldía Miguel Hidalgo, Ciudad de México, CP 11520, México, is also responsible for the use and protection of your personal information. In addition to the notice provided in the Woodside Privacy Statement we inform you as follows:

Withdrawal of consent

Should you not consent to your personal information being processed for any of the above purposes, you may communicate such opposition by contacting the Privacy Officer. Please consider that Woodside Energy Mexico may not be able to continue a commercial relationship or otherwise carry out the activities mentioned above if you oppose the treatment of your personal information as described in the Woodside Privacy Statement and this Addendum.

ARCO rights

In accordance with Mexican law, you have the right to know what personal information we hold about you, what we use it for, and the conditions of use we make of it. Likewise, it is your right to request the correction of your personal information in case it is outdated, inaccurate or incomplete; to have it removed from our records or databases when you consider that it is not being used in accordance with the principles, duties and obligations set forth in the law and applicable regulations; as well as to oppose the use of your personal data for specific purposes. These rights are known as (“**ARCO Rights**”). Any queries in relation to the ARCO Rights may be directed to the Privacy Officer.

Data transfers

Your personal information is processed by Woodside and Woodside Energy Mexico and shared with third parties as further described in the Woodside Privacy Statement. If we use your personal information to comply with the law, cooperate with police investigations or defend legal claims, we will do so in accordance with Mexico's Federal Law for the Protection of Personal Data held by Private Parties.
