

SCARBOROUGH PROJECT (NEARSHORE COMPONENT)

Nearshore Activities Weekly Project Update – November (Week 4) 2023

Activity Overview

- Shallow water lay barge (Saipem Endeavour) supported by anchor handling tugs, and supplied by pipe supply vessels has completed pipelay up to approximately KP 27.1 and is now de-mobilising from the project.
- Pipeline protection and stabilisation activities with the Backhoe 'Baldur' supported by flat top barges and the Rock Installation Vessel 'Seapiper' continue work on installed pipeline.
- A short extension of 700m was added to the trench between KP31.3 and KP32.0 within State Waters using the TSHD Gateway and Spoil Ground 2B. This work is complete.
- Support, survey and crew transfer vessels will continue to support these activities.

Environmental Monitoring Update

- Water quality monitoring sites located throughout the Dampier Archipelago, continue to record turbidity (sediment in the water column), benthic light, water temperature and depth.
- Remote sensing image (to the right) shows the spatial distribution of surface suspended sediment in the region on 25 November 2023 during transition between neap and spring tides.
