Safety Share

Woodside provided a short video produced by the Road Safety Commission demonstrating the importance of road safety during the upcoming holiday period.

Operations Update (refer to slides 10-13)

Woodside provided an Operations update, including on:

- Planned maintenance campaigns in 2026 at Pluto LNG and Karratha Gas Plant.
- An event in November to mark the first arrival of the Woodside Jirrubakura at our Karratha LNG facilities.
- Completion of the decommissioning campaign for one of Karratha Gas Plant's condensate storage tanks.

Projects Update (refer to slides 14-15)

- Woodside provided an update on the Scarborough Energy project including Pluto Train 2 modifications.
- Next year Woodside will continue to focus on minimising impact on the community. Overview provided of what next year will look like on the Pluto Train 2 project, including commissioning and start up. Commitment to provide further details at future meetings.

Community contributions (refer to slides 20-21)

Woodside provided an update on a range of community related topics including:

- A major refresh to the North West Shelf Project Visitor Centre to enhance visitor experience and update information on our operations and activity in the community.
- Progress on the Dampier Artificial Reef project, being delivered by RecFishWest, with environmental approvals secured and installation expected to commence later this month.
- The current capacity of Woodside's housing portfolio, which remains above 95% occupancy, and ongoing portfolio renewal initiatives including the delivery of 50 new homes and divestment of older housing stock.
- The ongoing Social Economic Impact Assessment, with work progressing and consultants GHD scheduled to undertake further stakeholder engagement in Karratha and Roebourne in February.
- The recent annual Clontarf Foundation vs Woodside Gaelic match held in Karratha. Woodside played a video sourced from Fremantle Dockers social media about the recent match held in Karratha joined by the Fremantle Dockers Community Goals team.

Summary of discussion

RecfishWest provided further details around the size and scale of the Dampier artificial reef and informed the group of similar reefs that had been deployed in Western Australia by RecfishWest.

Roundtable

A round table discussion took place, giving the CLG members the opportunity to provide an update from their organisation or community group.

Concerns

Woodside shared the Community Line and North West Communities email address for sharing with the broader community, in case of concerns or questions.

Meeting schedule for 2026 was shared.
