



Important Supplier Update

Dear Valued Supplier,

Woodside would like to inform you of an important upcoming change to our supplier onboarding and master data management process. While there is no immediate action required from you at this stage, we want to ensure you are aware of what is coming and why.

What is Changing?

Woodside is introducing **SAP Ariba Supplier Lifecycle Performance (SLP)** as the starting point for onboarding new suppliers and managing all existing supplier master data. This means:

- Suppliers will maintain their own account information directly in Ariba Business Network.
- Supplier registration and onboarding will be completed through Ariba Business Network.

When is this happening?

- The transition to **SAP Ariba SLP** is currently scheduled to go live on **3 February 2026**.

Why the Change?

We are transforming the way we manage our supplier onboarding and master data management process by adopting a cloud-based digital application. Suppliers will interact directly with Ariba Business Network as part of the registration and ongoing data management process.

A self-serve approach ensures suppliers maintain and update their own data directly in a secure system, reducing manual handling and minimising the risk of fraudulent activity by eliminating uncontrolled email or document exchanges.

How Will the Transition Work?

- From go live, **all new suppliers** will be required to create an Ariba Business Network account to complete registration and to maintain their account information.
- **Existing suppliers** will need an Ariba Business Network account to update key information such as banking details, address, contact information, or tax details. If you do not already have an account, you will be prompted to create one when making future updates to your account information. Registration is required to complete these changes.

- We will provide **clear, step-by-step instructions** to guide you through the registration process when it is time to register.

Please note, there is no cost implication to create an Ariba Business Network profile and activate a standard account to complete onboarding, registration and ongoing updates to account information.

Please share this communication with your Ariba Administrator (if your organisation is Ariba-enabled) or the team responsible for maintaining your account information.
