System Access and Login

Supplier representatives associated with active contracts in our records will have received an email with their system access details. The login email sent from <u>icm.service@icertis.com</u> provides instructions on accessing the system for the first time.

We encourage all suppliers to test your login and save the Icertis link to your favourites. Please refer to the available training materials to understand the steps for activating your account.

Furthermore, with each go-live release, as we move active contracts from the current system to Icertis, supplier representatives will be notified via email that their contracts are now available in Icertis.
